

Message and details for Premier Color Guard Clinic:

We are less than two weeks out from Premier! Not only do we get to experience what we plan on being a fairly normal show dynamic, we also have two exciting clinics planned.

For performers, there is a clinic scheduled featuring the captains from Onyx World. This clinic will begin at 7:30. Performers will have a 45 minute dance clinic, where they will learn choreography from the members of Onyx World. There will then be a 45 minute split session, where performers can choose between a flag class and a rifle class. At both equipment classes, performers will learn choreography from the members of Onyx World. Circuit personnel will be around to help guide students to the proper locations. **Performers will need their own equipment to participate, please plan ahead keep a flag or rifle out before packing away all show equipment.**

For directors, there will be a clinic regarding "How to Make the Most of Critique." This will occur at 7pm, and be over by 7:30 so that those who wish may observe the student clinics. Best practices for critique will be discussed by myself and two members of our panel - long-time WGI Judge Eric Kitchenman, and Kandice Wiggs. The signup form for critique will be passed around at this clinic, and critique will begin around 7:30, at the conclusion of the clinic.

Directors should have some time between the end of the show and the clinic to organize performers and give instructions. As indicated above, OIPA personnel will be in the halls to help organize kids while directors and staff attend the clinic.
